## **Team Member Guidelines**

De Colores! If you have already attended your Walk to Emmaus we encourage you to consider working as a team member on an upcoming Walk. Our Walks are held two times a year in Spring and Fall. Most members will tell you that the best half of the Walk experience is coming back to serve other Pilgrims. The following guidelines will help you make that crucial decision for service to the Emmaus Community and the Body of Christ.

- Working a Walk to Emmaus is intended to be a sacrificial act of service. As a new member to our Community, you will start out as one of our trusty Cooks – the optimal job for getting a big picture overview of the Walk to Emmaus from behind the scenes.
- The Board of Directors has the responsibility of approving all Team requests (as it does with Candidate Applications). Team and job selection is prayerfully accomplished based upon input from the Lay Director and Board. In order to make certain that enough Lay Directors are “coming up through the ranks”, the Board may sometimes directly assign a position to an individual. In all cases, the Team Members report to and are led by the Lay Director and Spiritual Directors for that Walk.
- Part of the Team Process is spiritual formation and team building of the team itself. As such, it is required that all Team Members attend all four team meetings (typically held on Saturdays from 9-2:00 PM), regardless of how many Walks you may have worked in the past. Each Team represents a new, fresh work in the Spirit and must not be treated casually.
- You must be able to pay for your team fees
- We ask that your commitment be bathed in prayer for our Pilgrims, your Team and our community
- Those who struggle with authority and working with others may not be right for the Walk to Emmaus Team
